Ms. Alguire is employed as a Senior Consultant with Willis, Graves & Associates, Inc. She performs crude oil and natural gas consulting services for mineral owners, producers, pipelines and purchasers. Ms. Alguire has completed offshore production platform and natural gas processing plant audits evaluating producer and royalty owner allocations and payments. Ms. Alguire has testified as an expert on market value and post-production expense issues.
